
The proposed development

Story Homes has an interest in land at Hadrian's Camp, off Houghton Road as a future housing development site. The site already has the benefit of outline planning permission. What this means is that the principle for residential development is established.

We are soon to apply for Reserved Matters (detailed design) planning permission for circa 110 new homes on one section of this brown field land. Subject to planning permission, we would look to commence building operations in Summer 2015 with approximately 30 homes delivered per year.



The intended application

Story Homes recognises that consultation is vitally important in the development process and in this respect we would like to inform you of our plans.

We are proposing to bring a brand new high quality housing development to the village of Houghton, delivering a wide mix of housing including up to 25% allocated as affordable allocated to local people.

The proposal will include a single road access off Houghton Road and potential new pedestrian/open space link to the open space between Antonine Way and Tribune Drive. We will seek to provide suitable ecology mitigation as well as provide contributions to meet school place demand.

The benefits of the scheme include re-enforcing the strength of the local economy and existing services as well as making good use of an existing overgrown brownfield site. The land will be restored to a safe use with existing materials and infrastructure re-used wherever possible.
