Subject: Trainee assistant site manager

I am currently a student at engineering school and I am actively looking for an engineering placement in the construction field. I'll start my 4th year of engineering studies. For a period of 16 weeks from September 2024, I would like to find an internship as assistant site manager, or project planning, design and dimensioning.

The construction sector is constantly evolving. During my course I acquired knowledge in the fields of mechanics, dimensioning, thermal engineering and modelling, and now I'd like to be able to use that knowledge in the field. We've been made very aware of the environmental challenges ahead and I'd like to be able to take part in this renewal of the sector.

I can also confirm that I have my international driving licence and my own vehicle.

Finally, the team spirit that I've acquired during group projects (building a robot, creating an articulated arm, managing a project with 20 people) and sports (handball, volleyball) that I play will be useful to me, as I know that construction projects involve a lot of workers and sectors of activity. I'm convinced that my organisation and ability to work with others will be key to ensuring that projects get off the ground.
