
Introduction

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
E-SPORT GAMING CENTRE

Architectural design is working with natural landscape and aim to reflect the latest trends with regards to digital design. The design incorporate sustainable and energy efficient solutions.



















Residential community living model targeting young professionals, who want to experience living in a city centre while pursuing early career opportunities.

Through strong relationship with surrounding city centre urban landscape of the Lace Market, Nottingham and sense of community, targeted audience can experience fuller life.

Natural colour pallet of the private apartment parts visibly contrast with light and colourful communal spaces; and with help of green elements create a warm and welcoming environment for its users.

Long, narrow site located on High Pavement Street resulted in need for natural light and mixed use ventilation within entire building. While the ground floor is kept fully as a commercial, the other floors are completely private, with first floor used for communal activities and spaces, and next two as a spaces for small, private apartments.





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
Calabasas is a city in a northwest part of Santa Monica Mountains region of Los Angeles county, California.

The project aim to re-design the existing hotel interior spaces, by creating a four-star experience using native landscape of the nearby canyon and colour pallet inspired by close-by cities.

Warm - pinky, beige tones with accents of blues desire to recreate the sunset experience of the nearby Malibu beach; the stronger terracotta shades represents the canyon walls; and the orange visible in every room relate to always sunny weather that can be experienced in Calabasas, but also act as a reminder for common for this area high fire hazards.

Environmental design include use of passive and active sustainable strategies such as mix- use ventilation, usage of natural light principles, high- efficiency plumbing, as well as renewable energy tools - solar panels and rainwater harvesting. Native plants and trees are used to reduce the transport costs and carbon dioxide emission.








DERBENT - DERBY BOTANICAL GARDEN PHASE1


This project will be delivered in three separate phases.


The first stage aim to produce a group master plan of the riverside area, located next to Derby city centre. The key aspect was to create a vibrant and attractive river-front targeting different age groups and types of people. The design include residential areas, office buildings, marina, shopping centre and entertainment venues as well as green park places. Part of the site is situated in a high flooding zone, so as a part of the development it was necessary to include the flood defence wall, which Derby city council is planning to built in the near future.


